## Accessible medical care and diagnostic testing – seven days a week.

When your health care need is immediate, but not life-threatening, see the caring professionals at South Baldwin Medical Center – Gulf Shores Urgent Care Walk-in Clinic. This walk-in clinic provides ER convenience for life's smaller emergencies.

Sinus infection? High fever in the evening? The Urgent Care Walk-in Clinic is open 24 hours a day, seven days a week – no appointment required. Our physicians provide diagnostic services and treatment for minor illnesses and injuries that are not life-threatening, but can't wait until regular office hours.

### ER or Urgent Care?

The South Baldwin Medical Center – Gulf Shores Urgent Care Walk-in Clinic is designed to complement your doctor's office by providing a place dedicated to treating minor injuries and illnesses that need priority attention.

Wait times at the Urgent Care Walk-in Clinic are usually shorter than an average emergency department visit. Patients are seen in the order in which they arrive; however, staff will assess patients according to the severity of their conditions. And, your out-of-pocket medical costs may also be less.

### Conditions typically cared for in our urgent care clinic include:

- Common illnesses
- Allergic reactions
- Asthma (mild to moderate wheezing)
- General wound care
- Rashes/skin infections
- Simple burns and cuts
- Strains, sprains, simple fractures and minor broken bones
- Vomiting, diarrhea and nausea
- Ear infections
- Insect bites
- Sore throat, colds, flu and fever
- Urinary tract infections
- Pink eye
- Fever

If you have a medical need and are uncertain about the right place for treatment, call your family physician first. Your doctor can assist you in determining the best place to go.

### The following symptoms should be treated in an ER:

- Severe abdominal pain
- Chest pain
- Trouble breathing
- Uncontrolled bleeding
- Excessive vomiting
- Loss of consciousness
- Choking
- Poisoning
- Sudden slurred speech
- Seizures
- Severe burns
- Head and back injuries

For critical emergencies, call 9-1-1, or go to the South Baldwin Regional Medical Center Emergency Department at 1613 North McKenzie Street in Foley or your nearest emergency room.



### What to expect during your visit

Upon arrival at our clinic, our medical staff will review your history, paying particular attention to your symptoms and concerns, followed by a thorough examination. If specialized care is not required, an individualized treatment plan will be developed and you will be instructed on any medications or additional therapy needed. Patients with more severe conditions may be referred to South Baldwin Regional Medical Center's Emergency Department.

To help expedite your registration process, please bring the following:

- A photo ID, such as a driver's license
- Your health insurance card
- A list of prescription medications, over-the-counter medications or herbal remedies you are currently taking.
